Our Amazing Projects this Summer While we are proud of everything we do, these projects showcase our versatility and skill.



Hudayrlat Island, Abu Dhabi

This project was to dismantle another tower crane erected on site The team used a TEREX DEMAG AC500-2 with 66m Luffer for this lob. The mobile crane had to be carefully placed between two existing structures for dismantle access. The team had to plan out a dismantle of some parts of the crane over the structure due to the way the structure was designed.



Nad Al Sheba, Dubel

This project was to erect the first tower crane for this new mall construction in Nad Al Sheba. The height of the tower crane was 40m. with a jib length of 70m so the team used 450 ton crane with 42m luffer for a maximum Lifting Radius of 49m and easy positioning of the tower crane



Downtown Area Dubat

This projects required the use of three spider cranes because this area is a tight urban area with very little space for a large crane. The team used these spider cranes to help with renovations on facades of multiple buildings and to occupy as little space externally as possible. The fact that these cranes were so compact allowed for some work to be easily done indoors as well instead of requiring other equipment



Mafraq Hotel ,Abu Dhabi

The team used the 860SJ Aerial work platform to help with the maintenance of the exterior lighting and balconies.



Ramhan Island Development

TLuxury homes and hotels in Abudhabi







In the fast-paced world of UAE's real estate market, luxury residential developments are constantly on the rise. Ramhan Island, located off the coast of Abu Dhabi, is one such project featuring multiple sea-front luxury villas, hotels, and retail spaces. Johnson Arabia has been a trusted partner for various developers on this ambitious project, recently executing a crucial 43-tonne lift for girder beams as part of the temporary bridge construction between Abu Dhabi City and Ramhan Island.

Johnson Arabia was appointed to lift the girder beams, each weighing 43 tonnes, for the temporary bridge. This complex task required the type of precision and expertise which Johnson Arabia is renowned for in the sector. The task facing the team at Johnson Arabia was to ensure seamless connectivity for the ongoing development, scheduled meticulously to align with the project timelines.

Johnson Arabia was chosen for this project due to its diligent and professional services, commitment to excellence, and deep understanding of the task's criticality. The company's track record in delivering exceptional service made it the ideal choice for ensuring the project's success.

Given the size of the loads to be lifted and the complexity of the wider project, safety was a paramount concern. Early into the works, Johnson Arabia conducted a thorough site survey to identify and mitigate potential risks. Working on the lift sub-contractor's advice and following a plate load test, the on-site contractors were required backfilling with 100% compaction to ensure the ground was sufficiently compacted. Wooden mats were additionally used to distribute the load of the tracks, further shoring up any remaining safety concerns. The project utilised a nearly 600-tonne crawler crane, specifically the Terex Demag CC 2800, equipped with a 72m main boom and 160t SSL. This enormous crane was chosen for its substantial lifting capacity and suitability for the project's demands.

Following the site survey, the team recommended reducing the crane size to 350 tonnes CC220 Terex Demag to optimise costs. They also adjusted the main boom length to 108m, enabling efficient reach to the secondary location from the initial crane position. This strategic modification ensured all lifting operations were completed on schedule with minimal delays due to crane adjustments.

As the UAE continues to develop its luxury real estate sector, Johnson Arabia's role in projects like Ramhan Island's bridge construction highlights the company's critical contribution to the industry-said Sreethu T, Engineering Manager for Johnson Arabia.

Safety and IPAF

Loading and unloading Of AWP equipment



Prepare a Risk Assessment – ensure this is completed ahead of any MEWP loading/unloading activity. Observe IPAF guidance when loading or unloading on or adjacent to roads.

Manoeuvre with care – take care when loading/unloading MEWPs and ensure drive orientation is confirmed at all times. Contact or collision with an object or person is the main causes of these type of incidents.

Be mindful of tip-over risk - ensure ramps are adjusted according to the MEWP being loaded.

Minimise pedestrian control – driving the MEWP from outside the platform should be kept to an absolute minimum. For instance, when manoeuvring through narrow doorways or under low ceilings. Operators/drivers should be spatially aware of their surroundings. Correct drive orientation must be confirmed at all times.

Avoid slips, trips and falls – ensure the bed of the vehicle is clear of debris and any edge protection. Ensure fall prevention systems are used as per the risk assessment.
